SAVE OUR FARM!! PROPOSED REZONING OF THE COLLEGE FARM

The State Government is proposing to rezone the land used by the Kiara College Farm for future residential.

As one of only two schools offering Agricultural Programs in the Perth metropolitan area, Kiara College has a very important role providing Agricultural Programs to high school students. It offers vocational agricultural courses and is a pathway to university courses such as Agricultural Science.

The Kiara College Board is not asking for the whole site to remain for the farm, but it does require a minimum of 12 hectares if the farm is to continue to offer it's wide range of agricultural programs

Please support us by completing a submission and tell the State Government that you **do not** support the farm being rezoned to 'Urban Deferred'. Submissions are due by Friday 18 December and can be posted to the address on the form or emailed to mrs@planning.wa.gov.au. The proposed rezoning of the Kiara College farm is one of a number of proposals so please mention "Proposal 10" in the relevant section of the form.

RETENTION OF YEAR 11 STUDENTS UNTIL THE END OF TERM 4

In 2015 the Kiara College Board has endorsed the retention of year 11 students until the end of the school calendar year- December 17. This would allow additional senior school time to provide opportunities such as:

- Year 11 ATAR course / exam review
- Extension of ATAR courses such that the 2016 Year 12 courses may be explored in advance and students given exposure to the 'leaps' of conceptual understanding / skills / processes
- Year 11 VET students are given additional opportunities and hours to demonstrate competence in UoCs that would contribute to acquiring Cert II or III qualifications in Year 12
- Year 11 VET students will be able to access industry relevant work experiences
- Year 11 students with category 1 or 2 classification

The Australian Government is encouraging submissions for ABSTUDY claims to be made to Centrelink before Christmas. Most claims can be lodged over the telephone with assistance from Centrelink staff. The ABSTUDY line is 1800 132 317.

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER

All students doing nationally recognised training need to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). This includes students doing Vocational Education Training (VET) when they are still at school (VET for secondary students). The USI will make it easier for students to record their VET achievements and ensure that students' VET records are not lost. If your student is completing any Certificate courses, they must have a USI. A parent permission form is available at the front office, or please visit www.usi.gov.au
