AHC20116 Certificate II in Agriculture

This certificate is designed for students who wish to learn about existing and new farming practices. The practical oriented course aims to develop a diversity of skills and attitudes in carrying out a range of activities including: animal & plant production, farm machinery & equipment and meeting workplace employment requirements. This qualification provides employment possibilities not only in agricultural industries but also other sectors, such as local government and small business.

50.7% of these 1.6 million jobs are located in Australia's six capital cities. A significant proportion of the employment generated in the capital cities is associated with the farm-output sector – such as finance, research, processing, packaging, transport, food retailing, accommodation, cafes and restaurants, racing industry, aquaculture, conservation and land management.

Students will have an opportunity to work to their strengths and preferred mediums in art making and there is a focus on developing practical skills that allow students to explore their creativity using a range of materials, working toward resolved artworks. Throughout the two years, students study drawing, painting, ceramics and sculpture. They will complete nine units over two years- leading to an exhibition at the end of year 12. Each unit has an accompanying booklet which must be completed to attain competency.
