



Year 11 SCHOLARSHIPS 2023

Introduction

Thanks to the generous support of the Crawley Rotary Club, Kiara College is offering two scholarships for students who are starting their Year 11 studies in 2023 at our college.

The Scholarship

There are two scholarships on offer. Each are for students entering Year 11 in 2023. All students are eligible to apply for the scholarship – whether you are studying an ATAR, General, Vocational or Big Picture Education pathway.

Both scholarships are in the amount of \$500 for the year. Scholarship winners are expected to remain at Kiara College for the year and to maintain good academic progress and regular attendance.

The scholarships will be awarded as a credit to the students' account and can be used towards Contributions & Charges, uniforms or excursions. This includes activities such as the School Ball and purchasing a Leaver's jacket. The Scholarship is not paid in cash, is not transferable and any unused amounts will not be refunded if the student leaves Kiara College. The College does request that winners advise the front office staff by email how they would like the money to be allocated within four school weeks of the scholarship being awarded.

The Scholarship may be withdrawn at the Principal's discretion for major breaches of school policies such as the assessment and behaviour policies.

Selection Criteria

Both academic and equity concerns will inform the selection process. Student attendance history will be taken into consideration when awarding the Scholarships.
